



NOMINATIONS FOR ELECTION (MRC) RANCH SORTING MEMBERS REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL

The Members Representative Council consists of SIX (6) members elected to serve a two year term. Only three (3) positions become vacant each year to allow for continuity within the group.

1. Full Financial Members are entitled to nominate for the Four (4) vacant positions. The newly elected members of the MRC will serve a two year term commencing the 26th July 2019.
2. Current MRC members **Rosie Dooley and Cathy Neale** will remain for a further twelve (12) month period. These two (2) members of the MRC will **not** be required to stand for re-election in 2019 and will have to re-nominate for election in 2020.
3. For a nomination to be accepted it must be made using this form only. Nominations close on Friday 17th May, 2019 at the ABCRA office not later than 5pm.
4. It is recommended that all nominees send the following;
 - a) a colour portrait photo attached which is suitable for publication.
 - b) a biography containing one hundred and fifty (150) words (approximately) outlining experience, goals and objectives. Email files will be accepted separately up until the close of nominations.
5. Valid nominations received by the closing date will be listed on a voting paper which will be distributed with the June 2019 issue of the Australian Bushmen's Campdraft & Rodeo magazine. Should there be three (3) or less nominations, there will be no requirement for a ballot.
6. Full Financial Members may nominate one or more Full Financial Members for a position on the Ranch Sorting MRC. A Full Financial Member may also nominate on their own behalf.

All nominees and their proposer must be Full Financial Members of the Association at the time of nomination. Any nominated member or proposer un-financial at the time of nomination will render the nomination invalid.
